

Christian Fathers Never Retire from Parenting

As we celebrate Father's Day this month, I want to be an encouragement to our fathers in this time of worldly economic despair. Many of us, all our lives we have been trained to operate according to the world's system; as fathers and grandfathers we must abandon the old world ways and habits and focus on teaching the Word to our families which includes walking in love at all times. We need those fathers with the misguided belief that providing monetary support is enough, to come out of fatherly retirement and display Godly integrity.
