In our modern society of automation, convenience is threaded through most interactions in our daily lives.. Waiting for food to be cooked has taken a back seat to microwaves and fast food restaurants, waiting in line to see a bank teller has taken a back seat to online banking; attending church has taken a back seat to television evangelist and downloadable sermons. Now, none of these conveniences are bad, but speak to a pattern contradictory to the doctrine of waiting. No wonder it is hard for many of us at times to wait on the Lord! The Merriam Webster Online Dictionary defines waiting in many ways with the primary being: To remain stationary in readiness or expectation or To look forward expectantly.. Waiting also

means anticipation, expectation, confident hope in something that will take place. To wait on the Lord means to learn contentment with his provision and timing in any given situation through fellowship with God—knowing Him, clinging to Him, and trusting Him. Now, we all may be in a different situation in which we are waiting on the Lord for a answer:

Maybe you are in a job situation that is not very positive and you are praying to God on whether or not you should stay or go in this economy. Maybe you were downsized or laid off and are in search of a new position.
Maybe you or a family member is sick and waiting for better news on the condition.
Maybe you are on a diet and praying to lose a few pounds.
Maybe you are a single person waiting for Mr. or Miss Right.
Maybe you are waiting for your spouse or child to become interested in the Word of God.
Maybe you are asked to participate in a project

or initiative requiring a significant time commitment.

In either situation, we must wait with an expectation of direction from the Lord. Fear, anxiety, stress and despair are all inhibitors to waiting and can cause us to be in a position or place that the Lord never intended for us. One challenge that I face is taking on things without waiting on the Lord to lead me in my efforts. I sometimes find myself stressed out and stretched so thin I barely have time to sleep. My mindset was the Lord gave me the talent to do this thing so I should do it. This is not always the case and

my husband stays on me now to ensure I am being led to do a particular thing or volunteer to remain in alignment with the Lord's Will. I do admit it is hard for me not participate if I know I have the skill set to do so or its something I am passionate about.. For example, recently, I was asked to assist with a church function and my response was, let me pray about it and I will get back to you shortly. I didn't respond this way because I didn't want to do it or didn't want to be helpful but another person commented as if I should be able to give an answer right then. I almost hastened my decision because I felt bad. I shot up a quick prayer and received that everyone may not understand my challenges and why I needed to seek guidance from the Lord. I am citing this example because I too learned at that moment to be more mindful of my interactions with others, they may be waiting for the Lord to order their steps as well and I should encourage them to wait on the Lord.
