Serve as an Acolyte!

There is no "fast rule," but usually this servant opportunity is reserved for our younger members. There is a special significance to what the acolyte does. First, an acolyte lights the candles. This signifies that the Holy Spirit is in the place of worship. By lighting the candles, you show those who worship that God is present in this house. When you extinguish the candles at the end of the service, you are signifying that the Holy Spirit is leaving the place of worship in everyone's hearts. Lighting and extinguishing the candles generally indicates the start and the end of a worship service.

Acolytes dress in robes, quietly carry torches, crosses, thuribles, alms basins and cruets. A vital part of worship, they blend into the background helping our liturgies flow smoothly, and rejoicing in the privilege to serve at God's altar.

If you are interested in serving as an Acolyte, or you have children that you feel might wish to serve in this role, please speak with Pastor Daugs.
