"MY WAYS ARE HIGHER THAN YOUR WAYS" God

"My thoughts are not your thoughts and neither are your ways my ways," declares the Lord. "Just as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts." [8th c. B.C., Prophet, Isaiah 55:8, 9]

It is always good for those of us who follow Jesus Christ and who endeavor to adhere to the principles established by God in his word and demonstrated in the Life and Teachings of Jesus, to remember that "God's thoughts and ways are not our human thoughts and ways." Though, we must confess, that we really do wish, at times, that God would get his thoughts and ways more in line with ours.

It won't happen! Frankly, we simply do not have the mental and emotional maturity or capacity to see the big picture or understand the enormity of what God has in mind for the human race. When we have trouble figuring out what to have for dinner or how to relate to a strong-willed child, how can we, on our own, presume to know what is the best way to come to a righteous and right conclusion regarding relationships with people of other races or cultures?

When we are stretched to our limits with the local Home Owner's Association on how often to cut our grass or how high the new fence should be around our property, how can we be so presumptuous to say that we know what is the best decision for guarding national borders or growing marijuana?

It isn't anything new? It has been the way of the human race since time immemorial. God did a very good job in leading the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt and made some very good decisions relative to their health and welfare for many years. It was a good relationship—as long as they paid attention to his directions. When they didn't pay attention, things didn't go too well. That should give us the first clue!

Example: Along the way, they decided they wanted a king like all the other nations around them. [I Samuel 8;1-9] God had been their King, but now they were rejecting him for a man named Saul. Saul was an "impressive young man without equal among the Israelites—a head taller than any of the others," [9:2], and he was later anointed by Samuel, at God's direction, as king over Israel.

The rest of the story shows that Saul was human, with feet of clay, making some good decisions and some bad decisions that impacted the Israelites with many difficulties. God had warned them, but they wanted a king anyhow. There, we have another clue!

The next time around, God chose the king that he decided should rule over Israel—a shepherd boy, but a man after God's own heart. Even though David had issues in his own life that would appear, from a human perspective, to disqualify him for such noble leadership, he was open to God's direction—including rebuking and correction. And God used him mightily to change the course of human history through the nation he had chosen to bring out of slavery to be his people.

Once again, we need to remember that "God's ways and thoughts are not our ways and thoughts." We need also to remember God said, "I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion." [Ex. 33:19]

As Sovereign God, it is apparent that God can raise up anyone he wants to be used in whatever way he desires to accomplish whatever he has in mind. And too, God has the ability to take whatever situation or person we may think is inappropriate or unqualified and work in that circumstance or that person's life to demonstrate to the powers of heaven and earth alike, his Greater Power and His Glory!

Perhaps it is best that we seek to think like God thinks in order to talk and walk in his ways. Jesus did!

INHERITING THE KINGDOM OF GOD

Jesus taught his disciples to pray that God's Kingdom come on earth as it is in heaven. As we endeavor to equip ourselves with spiritual gifts, we are better able to minister to people, inviting them into that Kingdom which has been prepared for us from the beginning of creation.

In one of his stories about the Son of Man [Jesus] coming in his glory, he tells those who have been faithful to him, "Come, you who have been blessed by my Father, take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world." [Matthew 25:34 NIV]

By the Grace of God and the use of The Spiritual Gifts that are given to us by God's Holy Spirit, we are able to share the Gospel through word—what we say, and deed—what we do. Empowered by his Spirit we are able to invite people to come into the Kingdom of God through Jesus Christ, our Lord. As he so plainly said, "I am the way the truth and the life. No one comes to the father except through me." [John 14:6 NIV]

It appears to me that Scripture makes it very clear that we do not **build** the Kingdom of God, as I have heard some say. We do not even **expand** the Kingdom by bringing people into it. It is rather presumptuous to believe that I have the ability to either build or expand God's eternal, spiritual domain.

God's Kingdom **IS** because God **IS**! He built it; He established it; He sustains it; He sets its boundaries; He rules over it. Where God is, there is his Kingdom!

We do not build the kingdom. When we are in Christ, we inherit it. "Now, if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings that we may also share in his glory." Romans 8:17

We have no power and we have been given no authority nor instructions by our Lord to build God's Kingdom. But we **do** have the power and the privilege of inviting people to come with us to Jesus and, by God's mercy and grace, enter his Kingdom family and be joint-heirs with him of that kingdom.

What greater privilege do we have as the children of God, than to share the good news of Father God's love demonstrated in Jesus—that we should be called "**the children of God"** and be co-heirs with Jesus of God's eternal Kingdom? What must that Kingdom be like?

"No eye has seen, no ear has heard, No mind has conceived What God has prepared for those who love him." I Corinthians 2:9

We may not be able to build God's Kingdom, but we can fall on our knees with deep gratitude in our hearts and unceasing praise on our lips for this inconceivable and indescribable gift of God's amazing grace and boundless love!




