WHAT CAN WASH AWAY MY SIN? NOTHING BUT THE BLOOD OF JESUS!

"Greet one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with gratitude in your hearts to God." Colossians 3:16

Singing has been a part of our Christian faith from the very beginning. Jesus and his disciples sang a song when they left the Upper Room to go to the Mount of Olives. The Illustration our pastor gave was perfect for what he was talking about. He said that you have a choice when it comes to dealing with weeds in your overgrown and unkempt yard. You can choose to try to dig them up one at a time, which is a never ending job, or, you can choose to use something like Roundup on it and kill everything all at once.

He went on to say that we can try to deal with our sins one at a time or acknowledge that the Cross of Jesus Christ is more powerful when it comes to dealing with our sins.

How true that is. On my own, I can choose to try to eliminate sinful thoughts, sinful words and sinful actions from my life one at a time. I'll just work on it and eventually it will work and I'll get it done. However, I find that it is somewhat akin to trying to pull out the weeds in the unkempt yard one at a time.

I can say to myself things like, "I'm not going to think that thought again. I choose to not think it." That's a good resolve. However, almost without even thinking about it, that same thought creeps back into my mind. Then, once again "I choose to not think it." And around and around it goes!

Well, I'll just not say what I'm thinking. I'll work on that. I may think it, but I'm certainly not going to say it. At least, I surmise, that is progress. Then, a circumstance arises in a conversation with someone that pushes a particular button that demands the kind of response about which I have been thinking and—out it comes, verbalized in sixteen point font

words. Foiled and Failed again!

On my own I am powerless to cleanse my life of sin. Only the Blood of Jesus has the power to kill sin in my life. I simply do not have the power or wherewithal—or sometimes, even desire, to do it.

Just as a chemical, like Round-up, can kill all the weeds and make the ground barren to any growth in the near future, so it can be with our lives when we are covered with the Blood of Jesus Christ.

The blood of Jesus is powerful in its effect. It not only kills the sin in my life, but, his blood and the Presence of his Holy Spirit, renders my life barren to any future efforts that sin may make to grow in me and He gives me the wherewithal to keep it out.

What can wash away my sin—and yours? Nothing but the blood of Jesus! There is power in his blood.

MOTIVATIONAL GIFTS SEMINAR IN ALABAMA

Those in attendance at the recent seminar in Alabama truly experienced the real presence of God's Holy Spirit.

This was the church's first experience with learning about the gifts that the Apostle Paul wrote about to the church in Rome, Romans 12:6-8, often called the Motivational Gifts of the Holy Spirit. These are the gifts that motivate us to function with effectiveness in the Body of Christ, the Church.

Following the teaching on Prophecy—taught by Jeremy Ellington, the workshop focused on listening to God and what God would have to say to the Asbury Church. Time was spent in silent listening prayer during which time the participants sought to hear what God would say to the church.

Each participant wrote down what they believed God had spoken to them. These "prophecies" where then used throughout the rest of the seminar for the workshops in each of the other gifts to discover how it would be lived out in the local church body. That is, how would a Server or a Teacher or an Encourager, for example, work to make that prophetic statement a reality in the church.

The results were powerful.

The following prophecy was used in one of the workshops and all requested that it be used during the Sunday Morning worship service—and it was with amazing results.

THE PROPHETIC STATEMENT USED IN WORSHIP

"Broken and poured out, this body has been broken by many who have tried to keep the church the same. I see your discouragement and disdain. I feel the hurt and scorn you have endured.

However, there is a new day coming.

I, the Lord, will bring new life and health to this body. I will place within you a new excitement and joy. I will open doors that no man can shut and there will be great joy, love and peace as you once knew.

Be aware, I the Lord will do this. No man or woman can create what I will bring. I, your Abba, will open the flood gates of heaven and you, my people, will see in the flesh what I have shown many of you in the spirit!

Be ready to receive this gift of life and hope, for you will be my light to this community. Abba"

Therefore, the dates of January 15-30 have been set aside for our trip to India. Details of the trip will be worked out with Jeremy and Joy. Our desire is to help strengthen their work there, even as they work with us to help strengthen our Lord's work here.

There will, of course, be expenses related to travel, housing, meals, equipment and all the other things that are involved in mission trips. If, in your prayer time, you feel led to participate in any way—such as being on the team or helping to provide prayer and financial support, we invite you to make your desire known to us in the Wind of the Spirit Ministries' office.

It is our desire to help to edify and strengthen the local mission work. Even more than that, it is our desire to bring honor to the Name of our Lord, Jesus Christ and glory to God, our heavenly Father. Won't you join us in that endeavor?
