Opening the Door to Healing

Healing is what we all want; healing of our spirits, bodies, souls, and relationships. God wants us to become whole and he is always at work in our lives to bring about healing leading to wholeness. His objective for our time here on earth is to shape us into the image of Jesus, who is completely whole, without any fault or injury. God has placed within our power ways that bring us to a point where healing can happen.

We are not even aware of the many ways in which our lives are broken and in need of healing. When we place our trust in Jesus, we gain access to the One who knows everything about us. The door to recognizing our broken places is open. We go through the door (Jesus) to our Father and ask Him to show us where He is at work in our lives to heal us. But we must be open to hearing what He has to say. It is an act of our will to truly listen to God's Word so that we understand Him and what He is about. Scripture tells us, "I love those who love me, and those who seek me diligently will find me." -Job 8:17

In Matthew 13:10-15 NLT, Jesus explains why he teaches with parables – simple stories that teach principles that are easily understood. Hear why Jesus does this:

"His disciples came and asked him, "Why do you use parables when you talk to the people?" He replied,

"You are permitted to understand the secrets of the Kingdom of Heaven, but others are not.

To those who listen to my teaching, more understanding will be given, and they will have an abundance of knowledge. But for those who are not listening, even what little understanding they have will be taken away from them.

That is why I use these parables, For they look, but they don't really see. They hear, but they don't really listen or understand. This fulfills the prophecy of Isaiah that says, 'When you hear what I say, you will not understand. When you see what I do, you will not comprehend. For the hearts of these people are hardened, and their ears cannot hear, and they have closed their eyes so their eyes cannot see, and their ears cannot hear, and their hearts cannot understand, and they cannot turn to me and let me heal them.

Jesus clearly tells the disciples that those who listen to His teachings will receive more understanding, leading to an abundance of knowledge. Those who do not listen, however, will not allow Jesus to heal them. "...they cannot turn to me and *LET* me heal them." The only healing in our lives comes from God and if we reject the way in which God chooses to heal, then there is no healing available to us.

In this passage of scripture, we see that understanding God's word to us is necessary for our healing. "...their hearts cannot understand, and they cannot turn to me and *let me heal them.*" We also see that our hearts become hardened because we stubbornly refuse to truly listen to God. "...they have closed their eyes". This is a deliberate act, an act of the will, to reject what God is saying. "He (God) is wise in heart, and mighty in strength: Who has hardened his heart against Him and has prospered?" -Job 9:4

Let us not be those who stubbornly refuse God's Word, whether from rebelliousness, busyness, laziness or indifference. We will not prosper if we refuse. On the other hand, if we put as much effort into searching the Word and really listening as we do into other things in our lives, we will prosper and receive healing.

'For this people's heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts and turn, and I would heal them.'


