WE ARE A WORK IN PROGRESS

This summer there has been a lot of road construction in our area. It has been underway for months and still is not completely finished, but the road I normally take began to look very different right away.

First, pipes were installed along the side of the road. Traffic could still get through, but it was slow with several stops along the way. The roadside was torn up and walls were built to shore up some of the steep parts, trees were removed, other areas were leveled out and heavy equipment was everywhere. It became very frustrating trying to find a route to get me where I needed to go.

I was running out of patience, so for a while I took another route and didn't see the changes that had been happening on that familiar road. When I did return to that road it looked very good. Not completed, but well on its way.

Isn't that the way it is for us who have placed our trust in Jesus. Changes happen, sometimes very slowly. God is at work in us and, because we are always in this body of ours, it is difficult to see the improvements in our lives. The work God does in us after we come to faith is the work of sanctification and it is a process. The Merriam Webster Dictionary tells us that "sanctify" means:

- 1. : to set apart to a sacred purpose: consecrate
- 2: to free from sin: purify

I don't know about you, but I struggle with the "old sinful nature" within me that is being purified. Sometimes all I can see are the places in me that are still broken, rebellious, and missing the mark.

God doesn't see us that way. He sees the finished work, much in the way a civil engineer sees what a road that he or she is designing will be like at completion. That engineer sees the finished work - his design - as it will be when completed.

The design God has in mind for us is that we be remade into the image of Jesus Christ. He sees the completed work. We are <u>in</u> Christ through faith.

The Apostle Paul struggled with the "old sinful nature" that was still in him after coming to trust Jesus. He says this:

"I don't really understand myself, for I want to do what is right, but I don't do it. Instead, I do what I hate. But if I know that what I am doing is wrong, this shows that I agree that the law is good. So I am not the one doing wrong; it is sin living in me that does it.

And I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature. I want to do what is right, but I can't.

I want to do what is good, but I don't. I don't want to do what is wrong, but I do it anyway. But if I do what I don't want to do, I am not really the one doing wrong; it is sin living in me that does it.

I have discovered this principle of life—that when I want to do what is right, I inevitably do what is wrong. I love God's law with all my heart. But there is another power within me that is at war with my mind. This power makes me a slave to the sin that is still within me. Oh, what a miserable person I am! Who will free me from this life that is dominated by sin and death?

Thank God! The answer is in Jesus Christ our Lord. So you see how it is: In my mind I really want to obey God's law, but because of my sinful nature I am a slave to sin.

So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death.

"The Journey Within"


