THE SIX \mathcal{R} 's OF OUR CHRISTIAN FAITH

When I was in grade and high school—a few years ago, there was great emphasis on the three "R's" in education: Reading, Riting and Rithmatic. Of course, nothing was mentioned about correct English in those three R's. Everyone seemed to just take it for granted that a person was smart enough to figure it out. All three were essential to a good, rounded education.

There are five R's that are critical to our spiritual growth and understanding of our relationship with God in Christ. These have been a part of our relationship with God from the time of creation. They are evident in God's historic relationship with Israel and they are still evident in the lives of those who claim the name of Christ. They cannot be taken for granted and they are not too hard to figure out.

RELATIONSHIP: God calls people into relationship with him. It is a covenant relationship in which God says, "I will be your God and you will be my people." It is a relationship initiated by God, based on God's mercy and grace and responded to in faith by those who desire to be in relationship with God. God desires relationship and calls us into relationship with him.. It is a relationship based on God's Love.

RELAPSE: There were times—and still are times, when those who are in relationship with God have a relapse. God brought Israel out of slavery in Egypt, but many wanted to go back. When they thought God was slow in responding to them, they erected idols to worship. They had relapses in their relationship with God.

We also have times when we have relapses. Though we walk in the Spirit of Christ, there are times when we fail to keep in step with the Spirit and respond, instead, to the temptations of the flesh. Though we have committed to a Christ-like lifestyle, our thoughts, attitudes and words do not reflect the Christ-like Spirit. We may become prideful, arrogant, boastful and self-righteous. Relapse!

RETRIBUTION: Throughout history, there have been consequences related to relapses in our relationship with God. Some of those were very dramatic and difficult for the Israelites, such as exile and loss of freedom. Others may have been less dramatic—such as droughts and crop failures, but they were still the consequences of bad decisions and wrongful behaviors, either on the part of the leader kings or the populace itself.

Likewise. God has set us boundaries in our relationship with him. "You will have no other God's before me." Or, "Love one another as I have loved you."

When we adhere to those boundaries and guidelines, things go fairly well in our lives and our relationships with others. However, if we choose to not follow God's directives, then there is retribution, which often comes in the form of broken relationships, lifestyles that bring disease and destruction to human life, as well as suffering loss of joy and peace in Christ.

Every wrong choice carries with it a consequence!

REPENTANCE: Repentance means to rethink what one is doing and turn to go another way. When Israel saw what was happening, usually under the guidance of a righteous prophet or king, the nation repented and was restored in its relationship with God.

God's Holy Spirit now reveals to God's people the areas of our lives in which there has been a relapse and then he brings us to repentance.

Repentance is not easy for it is very difficult for human beings to admit wrongdoing. For us it appears that it is very important to always have to be right even if we know we are wrong. One of our greatest sins is that of always having to be right. Pride! Self-Righteousness! These are the very things that cause relapses in our relationship with God and others.

Repentance is not just a personal thing for the individual, it is also a corporate thing for a local church, a denomination, the general church and, yes, a nation.

God spoke to the people of Israel through the Prophet Jeremiah, "I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more." 31:34b

The Apostle John states it clearly for the followers of Jesus Christ: "If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." I John 1:8,9

God is faithful to provide a way out of our life's various dilemmas, shortcomings and relapses, for "God is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine according to the power that is at work within us." Ephesians 3:20

The sixth R: **RESTORATION.** When God rescues us from whatever it is in which we may find ourselves, we are restored in our relationship with him. That restoration includes the restoration of the joy of our salvation, the restoration of peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and, yes, self-control.

That restoration releases God's Holy Spirit in the penitent heart to live the Christ-like life that God desires for those who are called by his name.

The Apostle Paul said, "Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit." Galatians 5:25. When we allow God's Holy Spirit to direct the steps of our lives, we will discover that our relapses will the fewer and longer inbetween; the retributions will be short lived because the Spirit will quickly lead us to repentance, and God's rescue is always at hand to restore us.

Through it all, God never lets go of us and we never lose our relationship with him, for "nothing can separate us from God's love." Romans 8:38,39.

At the same time, may the Holy Spirit keep us at the point where we never grieve the heart of God with our relapses, but bring him joy through our obedience! LLE
