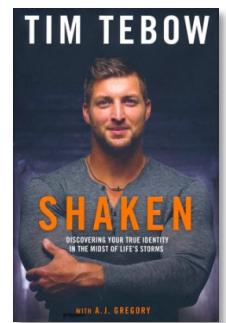
## ALL ADULTS: *Ephesians* followed by *Esther & Ruth*
