

#### Lenten Prayer Guide

Lent is the holiest of seasons on the Christian calendar and our spiritual prelude to Resurrection Day. It represents the forty day period of penitence between Ash Wednesday and Holy Saturday. It also represents the forty days Jesus fasted in the mountain (see Luke 4). Lent affords us the opportunity to recommit our lives to Christ.

About Fasting: Fasting symbolizes our commitment and sacrifice before God; it fosters a natural cleansing of the body and spirit and aids in concerted prayer and supplication and an "emptying" of ourselves. Of course, we should take responsibility for medical and health concerns; not all of us can eliminate food, but all of us can eliminate some type of food that we favor. Other chose not to fast from types of foods, rather the conscience decision to abstain from activities (television, meaningless conversations, tardiness, selfishness, etc.) Others have chosen to take on a mission or ministry or project during the forty day period, such as (volunteering at a soup kitchen, intentionally calling or visiting the sick and shut in members of the community, calling someone for prayer, mentoring a students, visiting a nursing home, etc.) The possibilities are many! Pause and consider what is God calling me to do today? How can I draw closer to God through my living and decisions?

This guide intended to assist each member of First Missionary Baptist Church who wishes to participate in Lent or join the collective body of believers in focused prayers and scripture readings. Select a time each day that you can commit to reading the brief scripture and prayer, and mediate on the questions being asked. This devotional will be completely private and the opportunity to share will be present on a volunteer basis. Please read through the Vision, Mission and Values statements of First Missionary Baptist Church. Ask God on a daily basis how can I be a part of the church achieving its Vision, Mission and Values, most importantly how can use this Lenten Season to draw closer to Christ in sharing in the cost and joy of discipleship.
