After the meetings, I drove home to be with Lilly for her Sweet Sixteenth birthday. In the middle of that, the Pastor of Weston's Victory Assembly of God called and said that he felt led to buy one tire and the board wanted to buy the other one! To make things even better, I told a friend of mine that owns and operates Mayflower RV in Mayflower AR about the situation trying to figure out my next step, and he suggested I buy a new dolly. He said if I wanted I could come there and he would give me a dolly. Because he was willing to be so kind I decided to go and buy it from him. He went to the trouble of getting a hitch and installing it and then just sent me down the road BILL PAID IN FULL! With friends like these, and like you THE WORK OF THE KINGDOM MOVES ON IN SPITE OF THE ENEMIES ATTACK!

We are so thankful for everything you folks do that words fail us. The words, "Thank you," are insufficient. BUT thank you for being partners with Terri, Lilly, and I in this ministry!
