Naomi Scholarship Requirements



The Story

The NAOMI SCHOLARSHIP is for women over 40. The candidate for the Naomi scholarship might find that she, like the woman of the Old Testament story, has been presented with incredible adversity or is possibly coping with life events that she never saw coming. Yet, she doesn't give up and presses on, seizing every opportunity and mentoring younger ones, sharing her wisdom to place people in incredible opportunities that have life-changing results. The ideal candidate for the Naomi Scholarship will be able to articulate how her own life models the story of a brave choice to seize opportunity despite life challenges, and use that opportunity to make a lasting contribution to the world around her.

Application Process

Applications will be accepted March 1st - May 31st of each year. The scholarship committee will review each application and render a decision no later than June 15th. The winning recipient will be notified within two weeks of June 15th.

Requirements

- ✓ Must be at least 40 years old at the time of application deadline (May 31).
- ✓ Essay describing why applicant is ideal based on Naomi scholarship description (400-800 words).
- √ Verification of enrollment at education institution or re-admitting for fall/spring semester (minimum six units or part-time schedule).
- ✓ Copy of unofficial transcript must be included in application submission. Transcript may be from college, high school, continuation school, or other accredited institution. If transcript unavailable, copy of high school diploma or GED may be substituted for this requirement. If currently enrolled in college, transcript must verify minimum 2.0 GPA/no failing grades.
- Minimum of two (2) letters of reference from non-relatives letters must be from any combination of the following: employer, teacher/former teacher, clergy, representative of a community group, or professional in the student's field of study.

To Apply

If you would like to apply for the Naomi Scholarship, please download a copy of the scholarship application located at http://www.ladybugministries.org/. Submitted applications must be complete and received between March 1st and May 31st of each year. Applications received outside of this period will not be considered. Eligible applicants need to be at least age 40, single or married, and will be able to provide school of enrollment information. Scholarships will be awarded to the individual, but funds will be provided directly to the educational institution.

Scholarship Committee

The Naomi Scholarship Committee is comprised of dedicated volunteers and officers of Ladybug Women's Ministries, Inc., who are active in their communities. Due diligence has been exercised to ensure that a wide variety of backgrounds, professions, and demographics are represented on the committee. Each member of the committee has a vested interest in touching the lives of women and empowering them to be world changers.

Naomi Scholarship Application Scholarship Award: \$1,000.00

Annual Application Period: March 1 through May 31

Applications postmarked after May 31 will not be considered; the decision of the Scholarship Committee is final and cannot be appealed.
