


Dear CCPC Friends,

Session Update February 2021

Pastor Susan declared the Annual Congregational Meeting informative and robust.

Evonne Tang, Finance Chair, reported that January offerings were behind, but that the church is also presently underspending. Offering income typically catches up in February and March. Session approved Finance Committee's nomination of Steve Webb as the next Treasurer, replacing retiring treasurer Bob West. Watch for a capital drive for live streaming equipment for our worship services.

Ann Fleming, Personnel Chair, reported that staff reviews should be moved to September due to budget planning. Rick Osborne's weekly hours are being increased to 40 but his pay will remain the same. Robin Seekford will be rewarded with a pay increase for completing ten years as CCPC Administrative Assistant.



- ◆ Kerry Connelly, the author of Good White Racist, will be with us on March 21 (ch. 7 & 8)


