Evangelism

- The preaching and teaching of the gospel of Jesus Christ
- The winning or revival of a person's commitment to Jesus Christ
- Also to include

 - o Tent Services/Services in the Park
 - o Clean Ups

Missions

- Establish relations and provide assistance with home and foreign missions
- Also to include
 - o Winter accessory giveaway
 - o Toiletries
 - o Bibles
 - o Socks
 - o Whatever the need

Social Services

- Efforts to advance human welfare and social work
- Activities designed to promote social well being
- Also to include
 - o Voter Registration Drive
 - o Brown Bag Lunch/ Clothes Drive in the Community
 - o Partnering w/ Nursing Homes and Shelters
 - o Youth March/Rally for Peace adopting an idea or focus of theme (Police Brutality, Education, Poverty, etc)

IMPLEMENT

Clearly show the existence or truth of something by giving
proof or evidence; Take part privately & publicly; Illustrate &
Explain with many examples; Exhibit
