Essential Job Functions:

- Cleans and maintains facility.

Requirements on the job

- Possess excellent communication skills and a strong team player with the staff.
- Ability to reach, bend, stoop, kneel, and stand for extended periods of time. Must have the ability to lift a minimum of 25 pounds and to have complete mobility in building and grounds activities.
- High School Diploma or GED required.
- Good organizational and planning skills, and an ability to delegate with staff and volunteers as needed.
- Ability to organize, coordinate, and schedule cleaning tasks for maximum efficiency
