Christ's direction to us in Matthew 28:19-20 is to: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

St. Paul tells us in Colossians 4:2-6 to: "Devote yourselves to prayer, keeping alert in it with thanksgiving. At the same time pray for us as well that God will open to us a door for the word, that we may declare the mystery of Christ, for which I am in prison, so that I may reveal it clearly, as I should. Conduct yourselves wisely towards outsiders, making the most of the time. Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer everyone." We are always mindful of these words from Scripture as we go about the work of campus ministry in the Omaha Metro area by living out our mission statement in all that we do:

"Our Mission is to Engage, Equip & Encourage Students to Seek and Share Christ" We are very privileged to have the opportunity to be a witness to the students in the metro Omaha area on behalf of the Nebraska District-LCMS and Pacific Hills Lutheran Church.

- The area provides us with a mission field of approximately 60,000 students.
- Research tells us that up to 75% of these college students do not have a relationship with Christ.
- That translates into approximately as many as 45,000 students who are in need of hearing the Gospel!
- This figure is more than twice the total number of baptized LCMS Lutherans in the three Omaha circuits!

We have expanded our ministry "foot print" from the University of Nebraska at Omaha to the campuses of Creighton University, Bellevue University, and the University of Nebraska Medical Center. Initial contacts have been made at several other locations, and this work continues in an effort to serve an increasing number of students in the metro area.

To facilitate this process we have designated campuses in the metro Omaha area as either "Tier I" or "Tier II". These designations are defined as follows: •Tier I Campus – Information posters placed on bulletin boards, 2 or 3 campus visits per year, minor contact with campus administration

•Tier II Campus – Information posters placed on bulletin boards, monthly campus visits, student organization status (if applicable), frequent contact with campus administration for the development of an on-going relationship of mutual support
