Open in prayer.

Read Matthew 5:27-37

- How would you define integrity?
- What problem did the Pharisees represent?
- What are some of the differing groups or areas in your life (work, home, etc.)?
- How aware are you of your personal image?

The Big Idea: Those who belong to the Kingdom of God live with integrity. We are people who understand that pure hearts, faithful living, and keeping our word are characteristics that honor God.

Jesus give three examples of integrity:

Integrity is a matter of the <u>heart</u>, faithfulness, and keeping your word.

- Why does Jesus condemn the idea of adultery?
- How does Jesus use figures of speech to make his point?
- What does Jesus mean when he says to "gouge" and "cut" what causes us to stumble?
- Why are marriage vows important to God?
- What should be our response to divorce?
- How does keeping our word as Christians affect our testimony of who Jesus is?

The two most important questions of your life:

- Do I trust God determines eternity
- Can God trust me determines the kind of life you will live

Are you trustworthy? Am I a person of integrity?
