Protocol Guidelines for AA Group Meetings

AA Group meetings must be approved, then placed on the church calendar.

All meeting attendees must adhere to protocol guidelines for the safety of all people who use and work in the church building. All meeting attendees need to sign this document when arriving for a meeting as a confirmation that they have read and understand the guidelines. The leader of the AA Group Meeting is responsible for ensuring all attendees follow the guidelines.

AA Group Meetings (until further notice)

- If you are ill, have fever or have been ill, please do not attend AA Group meetings.
- If you have had any contact with known COVID confirmed cases, please self-quarantine at home.
- Upon arrival no one should be let into the church building unless known to be a member of the AA Group. Do not allow someone to follow in behind you. The code to the church building should not be given to AA meeting attendees. Instruct attendees to use the buzzer to announce their arrival.
- A facemask is recommended, but not required for the protection of others. The AA group is responsible for having facemasks available in their room.
- Please use Hand sanitizer located at Ave A door, prior to going upstairs to the AA meeting room.
- Hand washing is critical to controlling the spread of the virus. Disinfectant wipes will be available in the restrooms and you are asked to wipe down surfaces that you have touched.
- The AA Group is responsible to have gloves and tissues in their room for attendees to use.
- It is recommended but not required to sit at least six feet apart from each other (front, back and to the sides), unless you live in the same household.
- Water fountains continue to be disabled at this time. The AA Group is responsible for having bottled water available in the AA room.
- The kitchen is NOT available for use, to include the ice maker. You can bring your own drink or pre-packaged snack to the meeting. Take all items that you bring in back out with you when you leave.
- The AA Group is responsible for the cleaning and sanitizing of the AA Group meeting room.
- Entry to the church will only be available through the Ave A doors for a meeting. *Please do not go to other areas of the church.*
- Restrooms are limited to the restrooms in the hallway close to the AA Group meeting room.
- When leaving the meeting, please maintain social distancing and remember although you may be comfortable with less than 6 feet of distance, those around you may not. .
