November 24 (Thanksgiving Sunday)

Part 3—"Four Things that Matter Most—Thank You" Sermon: "Sometimes, Not Often Enough" Scripture: Philippians 4:10-20

**Synopsis:** The words of a song have long said it best for me: "Sometimes not often enough, we reflect upon the good things, and those thoughts always center around those we love. And I think about those people, who mean so much to me, And for so many years have made me so very happy. And I count the times I have forgotten to say, thank you. And just how much I love them." In this week's passage, Paul, the dogmatic, often-times gruff theologian and missionary, takes the occasion to say what he often does not. Here, at Thanksgiving, we listen and learn."
