#### THIS WEEK'S SERMON

March 16, 2014

**Sermon:** "Relish the Moment" **Scripture:** Matthew 17:1-7

Synopsis: I want to come back to a passage Ray preached the first of March but look at it from a different angle. I remember the jingle from the old instant coffee commercial— "Celebrate the moments of your life." Those words transformed me. They represent the precise moment that coffee ceased to be just a beverage and became more a state of mind. Celebrate the moments of your life. Since then I've adopted a Starbucks way of life--pausing throughout almost each day to enjoy a moment of pleasure at my local coffee house. Critics of Starbucks who fuss about the relatively exorbitant cost of its drinks, miss the point. It's not about the coffee. It's never just about the coffee. It's about the mood, the moment, the time of pleasure fashioned by the occasion and the place. Gourmet coffee is impractical and that's the beauty of it. Christian worship is largely impractical, too. In fact, Marva Dawn has written a book in calling worship "A Royal Waste of Time." Not really, of course. Worship serves a purpose. But that's not primarily the value of worship: that we come to the sanctuary to get some business done. Worship has intrinsic value. It's valuable in and of itself. Which leads me to this week's passage. Jesus on a mountain with Peter, James and John. In the long stretch of God's Kingdom work I don't suppose that mountaintop moment was the most productive time of their lives together. As far as I can tell, there was no bottom line. And yet, Peter was right: "It's good for us to be here."


### **2014 CHURCH DIRECTORY**
