## THIS WEEK'S SERMON

May 11, 2014 (Mother's Day)

Living the Resurrection of Jesus Christ in our Everyday Lives, Sermon #3

**Sermon:** "Around the Dinner Table" **Scripture:** Luke 24:13-24, 28-35

**Synopsis:** The Gospels say repeatedly that it is in the sharing of an ordinary meal that the Risen Christ is experienced by believers (the disciples of the Emmaus road, the disciples called to breakfast in John's gospel). This gospel fact suggests that our souls are formed by the power of Resurrection not necessarily in extraordinary occasions, but in the common routines of breaking bread. Peterson writes: "Formation



by resurrection does not depend on a specially prepared setting or a carefully selected time and place. The norm is the normal. There is nothing more normal and routine and everyday than eating a meal." Later Peterson observes that while specially planned programs of spiritual formation such as bible studies are important, over a lifetime, the unnoticed and unrecognized presence of the risen Christ at our meals may be more formative of the life in Christ in us." (42) This week, we look not only at the value of ordinary meals, but how in the breaking of bread our relationships with the Risen Christ are formed.
