MOMENTS REFLECTIONS

Peter Steinke, one of my professors at Austin Presbyterian, has written several books describing how church families mirror the same emotional complexities as one's own personal family. (Some of his works include, **How Your Church Family Works, Congregational Leadership in Anxious Times, Healthy Congregations**). Steinke draws from a whole body of systems theory research in saying that a congregation is a fluid emotional system. Meaning? Everything that is true of you and your family is typically true of your church family, only magnified by the number of personal family units in the church (think x120!).

And so? When families experience change, for instance, even for the very best of reasons, it tends to introduce an element of stress into the emotional system. Even if there is anxiety among a few members of the church family, the whole congregational system tends to feel a degree of anxiety. Think of it this way. One small pebble thrown into a large pool of water produces a much larger ripple effect.

Why do I say all this? Because, while our church is experiencing a great number of tremendously positive changes (our church's Young Families and Professionals Ministry, for instance), the landscape of our church system is changing. And though we celebrate these changes, and understand their necessity, we (some of us) are nevertheless anxious.



Perhaps it helps to know that this is a normal experience in the face of any change. Perhaps it also helps to know that only healthy, living, growing churches experience the discomfort of change. Perhaps it also helps to know that while we need to take stock of our feelings in the face of change, God is present to help us move forward with courage. —Dan

THIS WEEK'S SERMON

May 25, 2014 (Memorial Day Weekend)

Sermon: "Shepherd in Combat Boots: The Mightiest Weapon of All"

Scripture: John 15:12-14

Synopsis: Supporters of the Rev. Emil J. Kapaun, an Army chaplain who died a prisoner in the Korean War, are still working to have him declared a Catholic saint for his life-saving ministrations to them. But last year they relished the joy of seeing him posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor by the President. His story makes grown men cry. His sacrificial spirit is a sermon all its own. Perhaps Father Kapaun truly is a saint. Or maybe, he's a man, a soldier, a Christian who dedicated his life to Jesus' mandate: "That we lay down our lives in loving one another as Christ loves us." How ironic that in a war of guns and bullets, a great story of valor was told with neither.
