

Duties of Elder

All Elders shall promote the growth and welfare of the Church; provide spiritual direction for members with respect to regular attendance at the Lord's Table on Sunday mornings; serve Communion to Homebound members; give thoughtful consideration to policies that will enable the Church to fulfill its complete mission; encourage by example and word of missionary, evangelistic, educational and stewardship responsibilities of the Church; and perform other specific additional tasks that might be assigned from time to time.

The Elders will organize with a Chairperson and a Vice-Chairperson and will meet monthly to confer with the Minister and his Associate on spiritual matters of the Church.

Elders shall:

- Regularly attend the General Board Meetings
- Regularly attend the services of the Church
- Express a willingness to serve as a member of one of the Functional Ministries
- Support the Church financially to the best of one's ability
- Promote good will and Christian Fellowship within the Church family, strengthen the varied programs of the Church, and aid the Minister(s) and membership in making the total life and work of Church relate to the purpose of God as revealed in Jesus Christ.
- Strive toward continual personal growth in Christian Stewardship
- Strive for continual personal spiritual growth
- Actively support the mission of the Church
