

Duties of Worship Ministry

Both Traditional and Contemporary Worship Ministries assists the Minister(s) and other worship leaders in providing meaningful worship experiences and encourages personal and family devotional life.

The Traditional Worship Ministry shall be responsible for:

- (a) Providing music, ushering, special services when needed, and assistance with baptisms.
- (b) Providing speakers for the Worship Service in the absence of the Minister and Associate Minister(s).

Contemporary Worship Ministry shall be responsible for:

- (a) Providing leadership for each part of worship including acolyte, welcome to worship, music, ushering, communion meditation, offering meditation, children's sermon, scripture reading, baptisms, etc.
- (b) Provide leadership and planning for the physical components essential for the service.
- (c) Planning and implementing special services.
- (d) Providing speakers for the worship service in the absence of the Minister and Associate Minister(s).
- (e) Representation at Worship Ministry Meetings.
