

THIS WEEK'S SERMON

Sunday, January 27, 2013

(Consecration of Board Leadership) Sermon: "By Whose Standard?" Scripture: Nehemiah 8:1-3, 5-6, 8-10

Synopsis: On this occasion when we gather to consecrate a new body of church leadership—Elders, Board officers, Diaconate, Trustees—I'm drawn to the relatively unknown Old Testament book of Nehemiah. Nehemiah writes in the long years after the exile of God's people. Earlier in his book, he describes with great passion his desire to return and rebuild the Temple walls. Now, in the process of rebuilding those walls, the builders discover a scroll. The scroll is nothing less than the forgotten word of God. In haste, all God's people are summoned to come and hear the Word of God read to them. In the reading, the great gap between God's vision and their lives are described. In the beginning, before the exile, the people knew by whose standards they were to pattern their lives. But time and trouble obscured the once clear vision. It strikes me that in every generation, in every church, there's great value in going back to the beginning to make certain that we remember, are clear in our minds, exactly whose standards we're to follow in being one of God's leaders. Perhaps we serve best by first listening to God's Word.


