




THIS WEEK'S SERMON

Sermon: "Naomi's Hope"
Scripture: Ruth 1:1-18

Synopsis: Naomi was widowed, aging, barren, on her way back home. She is a picture of utter hopelessness: no future to anticipate, no place to call home, bereft. Yet, Naomi has Ruth, and scripture says Ruth "clung to her." It's the most tender, memorable, part of an otherwise obscure Old Testament book. Beginning with Ruth's remarkable vow of abiding presence, Naomi's future begins to emerge. Together these two start a new chapter of hope. Let this be parable to each of us about how God offers us new hope: not through some miraculous intervention; not on a mountain-top with the heavens splitting open. Rather? Through the simple presence of ordinary people.
