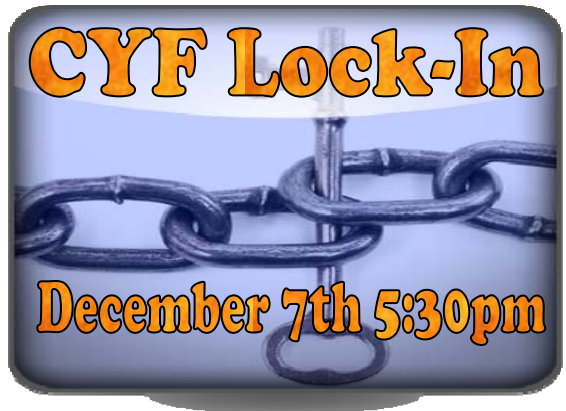

THIS WEEK'S SERMON

November 18, 2012

Sermon: "Living God's Dream"

Scripture: 1 Samuel 1:4-20

Synopsis: The high school commencement speaker stood at the podium and in his address urged the graduates to have a dream, to follow their dream, to let no one or nothing stand in their way. And this sort of talk is fine but it isn't particularly Christian. Christians are people who are attempting to live out God's dream, to live their lives in such a way that God may get what God wants. In this week's passage God hears Hannah's prayer. She prays to God for a son and God's grants her plea. Only the gift entails an assignment. Hannah's child, Samuel, is given as a gift not only to fulfill her personal dream, but to serve God's holy purposes. What gift has God given you? And how does God want you to use that gift to serve him? This Sunday before Thanksgiving perhaps we can pause not only to give God thanks for all the many blessings, but also to ponder how God wants us to use those gifts.
