
We welcome Rodney & Tammy Wolfe and their two children, Evan & Kristen. The Wolfe family joined First Christian Church Sunday, February



Spring Bible Study

Sunday, March 3rd & 10th at 6pm Prayers of the Psalmist

The class will meet for four Sunday evenings, 6-7 p.m., in the chapel. The topic, "Prayers of the Psalmist," draws from the work of theologian Walter Brueggemann, who, years ago, suggested that the various Psalms, all 150 of them, could roughly be divided into three categories: three occasions in life, three seasons, that are common to every spiritual journey.

March 3—Psalms of Disorientation

These are the Psalms that give expression to those times of life when, as one writer has put, our assumptions about the relative fairness and rightness of life have been challenged. Times of trouble, or suffering, or doubt. Here, we pray for God to disclose Godself.

March 10—Psalms of New Orientation

These are the Psalms that give voice to new understanding, a regaining of lost hope, or a strengthening of hope following an occasion of loss. We are changed through seasons of loss. Yet in Psalms of New Orientation, we begin to incorporate life's losses into a new found sense of life and hope.





THIS WEEK'S SERMON

Sunday, March 3, 2013 (Lent #3) Sermon: "Even Father Abraham" Scripture: Genesis 15:1-12, 17-18

Synopsis: We sometimes gloss over things in the Church. We don't mean anything by it, but our penchant to present neat and tidy narratives of faith sometimes hurts more than helps. Take the story in the New Testament book of Hebrews. The writer devotes an entire 11th chapter to a listing of the so-called "Roll Call of Saints." In it, the writer talks about the great one of faith, our spiritual ancestors who, like Abraham, for instance, "by faith obeyed when he was called to set out for a place that he was to receive as an inheritance; and he set out out, not knowing where he was going." (Hebrews 11:8) It is true, of course. Abraham did follow God's call. But not so quickly. In the beginning, in this week's passage, Abraham doubted; asked of God, "How am I to know?" I don't mean to diminish Abraham's faith, but I do mean to point out that in Scripture faith and doubt aren't necessarily exclusive. Even in the best of God's disciples there is doubt..
