

Youth Ministry News







THIS WEEK'S SERMON

Sunday, February 10, 2013 Sermon: "Before You're Called" Scripture: Luke 5:1-11

Synopsis: I was talking to a medical student recently. I asked her where she was in her program, how long it'd be before she graduated, what her plans were after school. For the next ten minutes she gave me an elaborate description of what more was required to be licensed to practice. More classes. More tests. Months of supervised training. And I suppose that's a good thing. You don't want someone operating on you, giving you medical care, if they don't know exactly what they're doing. Seminaries are doing better at this than they used to. We're beginning to understand that just as untrained doctors can do a lot of damage, so too clergy who get a license to care for a congregation of souls. But what about being a lay leader in the Church? What training? What classes? What sort of supervision or pre-requisites do we, should we, require? What proof do we need to be assured that a chosen leader is fit for the task at hand? In this week's passage (as in the Old Testament lectionary reading from Isaiah 6:1-8), I'm struck by a common perquisite for service. Before Peter and the others are called to be fishers of people, before Isaiah is called to be one of God's prophets, something happens. This Sunday, I want to examine what Scripture says is a necessary prelude to effective leadership in God's

Spring Bible Study February 17th & 24th, March 3rd & 10th 6pm Prayers of the Psalmist

The class will meet for four Sunday evenings, 6-7 p.m., in the chapel, beginning Sunday, February 17. The topic, "Prayers of the Psalmist," draws from the work of theologian Walter Brueggemann, who, years ago, suggested that the various Psalms, all 150 of them, could roughly be divided into three categories: three occasions in life, three seasons, that are common to every spiritual journey.

February 17— Psalms of Orientation

These are the Psalms that give praise to God in times of relative peace—times when life is as it should be, when life is in order.

February 24—Psalms of Disorientation

These are the Psalms that give expression to those times of life when, as one writer has put, our assumptions about the relative fairness and rightness of life have been challenged. Times of trouble, or suffering, or doubt. Here, we pray for God to disclose Godself.
