This Week's Sermon

Sunday, June 2, 2013 Sermon: "What's the Use of Worship?" Scripture: Galatians 1:1-12

Synopsis: Ideas about the importance of worship have changed over the years. In my childhood days, likely because I was a preacher's kid, people went to worship because that's what Christians did on Sunday morning. I'm not saying habit is the best reason to come to worship, but it beats what's evolved through the ensuing generations. Over the last several years, as parents of the Greatest Generation begat Boomers, who begat Gen-X's, who begat Millennials, who begat children of the New Silent Generation (Gen-Y), worship has increasingly become less a matter of habit, and more a matter of finding satisfaction for one's felt needs. Therefore, today, more and more folk think about the practical value of worship asking such questions as "What does an hour of worship contribute to my life?" or "How does worship help me, motivate me, calm me, or excite me?" The problem, as I see it, as Scripture seems to teach, is that worship, can't be, shouldn't be, judged by such human standards.
