Pastor P's Perspective

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Grace and peace!

In case you haven't yet heard, a local artist has been selected to paint a mural on Brentwood Bowl to represent Springfield Township. Cincinnati has become covered in beautiful murals and I think the idea to represent our community this way is a good one. There is just one problem: the subject matter.

The work is to be called "Creatress" and is meant to be a tribute to "Mother Nature." As a Christian, I'm less than impressed, and would have much preferred a more biblical understanding of creation. Yet the reality of the situation is that we live in a secular, worldly society where truth has become relative. Fewer and fewer people identify as Christian, and even fewer among them know and accept the biblical Christ!

Friends, we are strangers in a strange land. Our home is not of this world, our citizenship is in heaven (Philippians 3:20). That being the case, I have begun to think of this secular, humanist mural as an opportunity for us who believe in God's Word to proclaim the truth of creation to a community that does not know. And just what is the truth of creation? Look to the first chapter of the gospel according to John for the answer... that "in the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God and the Word was God. "He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made. In him was life, and the life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it." We further confess this in the second article of the Nicene Creed, that "through Him all things were made."

When we see the mural of "Creatress" in our community, let us be reminded of the truth of creation by the Word— who is Christ himself. Then let us endeavor to share the truth of God's Word with our community and the whole world, to the glory of God— Father, +Son, and Holy Spirit!






