Pastor P's Perspective

Worship

Often when we think of worship, our minds turn to Sunday morning. No doubt, Sunday worship is the central point for the gathering of our community around Word and Sacrament. We come together to sing and praise, to reflect on God's graciousness and to receive His mercy and forgiveness. We take joy in this gathering of our community—friends and family, brothers and sisters in faith, as we rightly should.

Yet, we must understand that worship is not only a Sunday morning activity. Worship is central to the whole of Christian Life—day in and day out. Indeed, this is what we were created for—to praise and give glory to Almighty God. Those who studied Revelation know that our life in the Kingdom is one of continuous praise. As we wait for the Last Day with great anticipation, we begin our praises now, and "practice" for our ultimate role in God's Kingdom. So what does daily worship look like? How can we adopt a practice, not only of regular attendance at church, but of a lifetime of continuous worship?

It's actually quite simple. Pray—anywhere, anytime. Prayer is worship. God is always near to us and hears the prayers of his children. Don't worry about "constructing" a "proper" prayer. Just pray and trust that the Holy Spirit intercedes for us before God. Some are unsure of how to pray, or how they should pray. In answer, I can give nothing better than the answer Jesus gave when His disciples asked the same thing: "When you pray, pray this way: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name..." Luther suggested the following: "In the morning, when you rise, you shall bless yourself with the holy cross and say: 'In the name of God the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost. Amen.' Then, kneeling or standing, repeat the Creed and the Lord's Prayer. If you choose, you may, in addition, say this little prayer: 'I thank Thee, my Heavenly Father, through Jesus Christ, Thy dear Son, that Thou hast kept me this night from all harm and danger; and I pray Thee to keep me this day also from sin and all evil, that all my doings and life may please Thee. For into Thy hands I commend myself, my body and soul, and all things. Let Thy holy angel be with me, that the Wicked Foe may have no power over me. Amen.' Then go to your work with joy, singing a hymn, as the Ten Commandments, or what your devotion may suggest."

He goes on to prescribe a similar form for evening prayer, including this prayer: 'I thank Thee, my Heavenly Father, through Jesus Christ, Thy dear Son, that Thou hast graciously kept me this day, and I pray Thee to forgive me all my sins, where I have done wrong, and graciously keep me this night. For into Thy hands I commend myself, my body and soul, and all things. Let Thy holy angel be with me, that the Wicked Foe may have no power over me. Amen.'" (Small Catechism) Yet, prayerful worship may take on still other forms, such as singing hymns and praise songs to the radio as you drive. Now that I think of it, I pray a lot when I'm in the car (and all the more now that my son is learning to drive). Praying before each meal is another fine way of adopting a regular life of prayer.

No matter how we do it, no matter where we are, we do well to pray always to worship in every part of our lives—to call on God in our need, and to praise Him for His grace in Christ. Indeed, this is the first step in the process of discipleship of a closer walk with our Lord.

"Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. Do not quench the Spirit."
