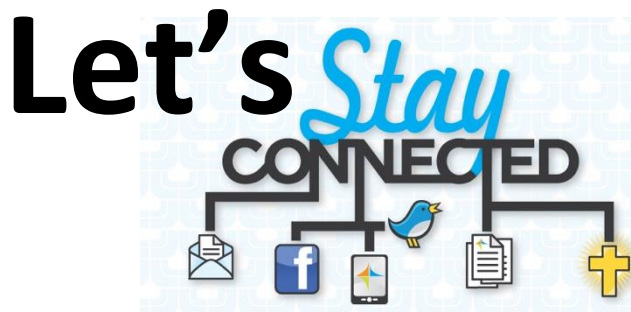

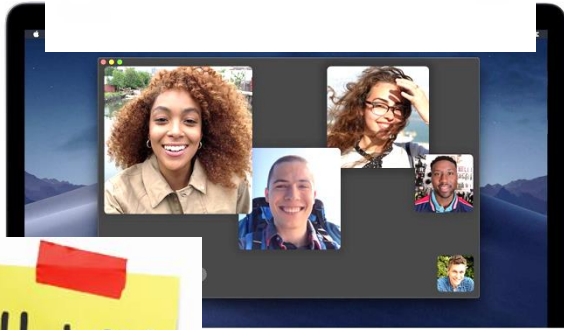

Sore throat or Cough	Pneumonia 
Muscle pain	Sepsis, even death in some cases 

A general feeling of being unwell

Coronaviruses usually cause mild to moderate upper-respiratory tract illnesses

Symptoms may appear between **2-14 days** of exposure

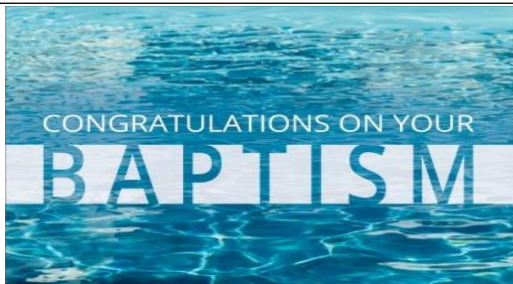
