



MISSION: CHRISTMAS by Shawn Compton

The Missions Ministry Team is gearing up for *Mission: Christmas, King Avenue's Alternative Giving Experience*. This year we are going to focus on four new Mission Opportunities. Our dates for the alternative giving offering are December 4, 11, and 18th, 2016.

Our plan is simple: We will have special Mission Christmas envelopes printed with opportunities to give to one of the four new KAUMC-mission opportunities. They will be...CASA of Franklin County (CASA of Franklin County's mission is to provide a powerful and consistent voice in court for the innocent child victims of abuse and neglect); CHOICES (For Victims of Domestic Violence); Greater Hilltop Shalom Zone (An Energetic Movement for Justice, Peacemaking, and Renewal of Columbus' Hilltop Community); and Stonewall Columbus Refugee Resettlement Program (For Outreach and Support to the LGBT refugee community).

You will place an amount next to each mission to which you want to contribute and will enclose a check or cash in that amount in the envelope. The envelope will ask you to include your name and e-mail address. The church will provide gift cards for each donation which can be picked up at the Mission Christmas table set up in the milling area of the church after each service. You will be responsible for mailing out the gift cards to the gift recipient.

The Mission Christmas envelopes will be stuffed in Sunday morning bulletins December 4th, 11th, and 18th.

Year-End Contributions

As we near the end of the year, many people will want to catch up on their 2016 King Avenue UMC pledge or make additional donations. There are several things to keep in mind if you want your contribution or pledge to be deductible on your 2016 income taxes.

If you are issuing a check or cash donation to the church, the effective date of your contribution is the date that it is hand delivered or mailed. Thus, please make sure that any 2016 contributions are post marked on or before December 31 or hand delivered to the church office no later than 3pm on Thursday, December 29.


If you plan to give via our new online giving feature using a credit or a debit card - <u>http://www.kingave.org/worship/giving.html</u> - please ensure the donation is posted to the system no later than 2pm (EST) on Thursday, December 29 to ensure

it can be recorded as a 2016 gift (as it takes 24 hours to process). Donations made on Friday and Saturday won't be processed until the next week and will be considered a 2017 gift.

The IRS requires that all pledges or donations collected on the first Sunday in January (whether they are intended for your 2016 or 2017 pledge and regardless of the check date) be reported as 2017 contributions for income tax purposes. There are many tax advantages to transferring appreciated stock to the church. If this is something you are interested in doing, please ask your broker to contact Robert D. Meyers at Wells Fargo, (866) 507-5839. To qualify as a 2017 donation, the stock must be transferred into King Avenue's Wells Fargo account #4197-6905 no later than the close of business on Friday, December 30. Also, please notify Rebecca Naas , <u>rebecca@kingave.org</u>, or me of your intention so that your giving statement can be properly documented.



UPDATE ON HABITATE FOR HUMANITY MISSION TEAM

King Avenue is part of the Hilliard Adopt a House, an affiliate of Habitat for Humanity. The Volunteer in Mission Team from King Avenue has participated in completing one house build in 2015 and the rehabilitation of two houses in 2016. For the first build in 2015 on Genessee, we had 22 King Avenue volunteers for a total of 776 volunteer hours. This year the first rehab on Bellevue we had 13 volunteers for a total of 135.5 volunteer hours. The second rehab on Third Ave we had 12 volunteers for a total of 205 volunteer hours. As you can see, the Volunteers in Mission Team has been busy.!

This past fiscal year King Ave had 9 volunteers with 50 or more hours. I would like to give a shout out to Bob O'Connor with over 150 volunteer hours.
