During the summers literally thousands of children, and parents alike, have been touched by Chip's songs, stories, funny faces and weekly performances.

Chip's songs range from rollicking, fun, bash around tunes, to songs that are very spiritual, but not at all preachy. He was named Best Family Musician by Lake Erie Living Magazine in 2017 and is a 2x Ohio Music Award winner for Best Children's Song. His CD *The Dream Tree* received a Parents Choice Award and his music has found a place on both Christian and secular kids radio programs around the country. Chip Richter's music offers a tranquil, folk appeal that is soothing to the soul and finds a welcoming audience among parents as much as children.
