

Altered Book Class Monday, October 7, 2019 7:00 p.m. in the Gallery Instructor: Kurt Reichert


Altered books are a very popular form of artistic expression. They give old volumes a new lease on



Description: Through storytelling and open dialogue, community members will engage in discussion about gender identity and transition with transgender individuals, their family members, and clinicians who practice with transgender/gender diverse youth. is <u>https://www.columbusmarathon.com/course-map</u>. Special instructions from the race organizers for King Avenue worshipers are as follows. The route this year travels on the North side of Fifth Ave. between Hunter and Neil, and the East side of Neil Ave. from Fifth Ave. to OSU. The first wheelchair athlete will be passing by at about 8:15 a.m., and the last walker at about 11:15 p.m. The west side (southbound) lane of Neil Ave. is open between 12th and 5th avenues, and traffic and travel in either direction on King between 315 and Neil. Also, the police will allow traffic to pass through gaps in the runners, so if someone is trying to cross Neil it can be done (with a little patience).
