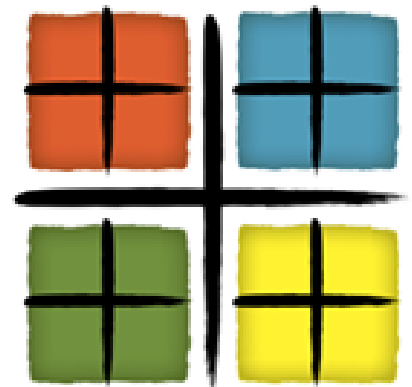

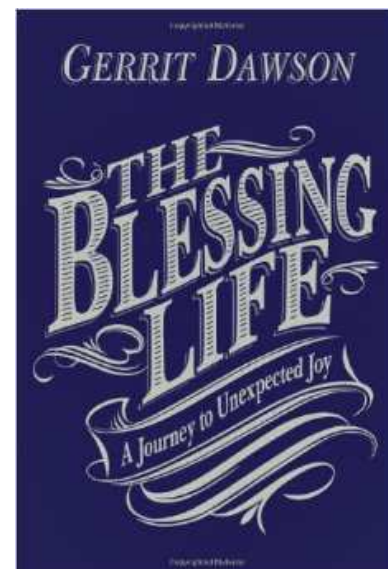

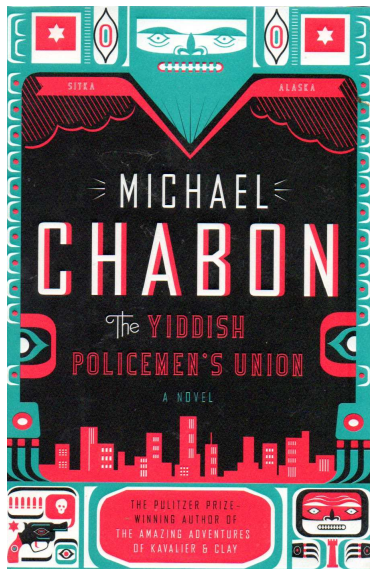
Lunch in the Park with the Pastor(s)
