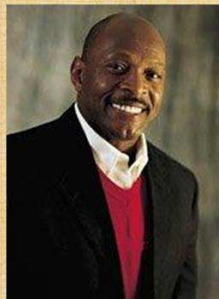

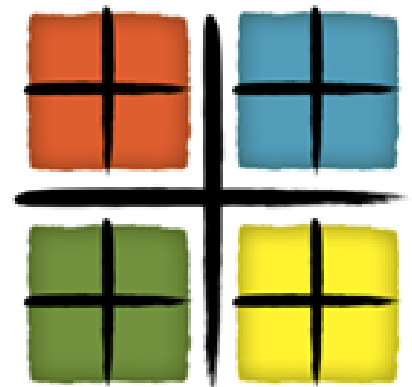

German Village

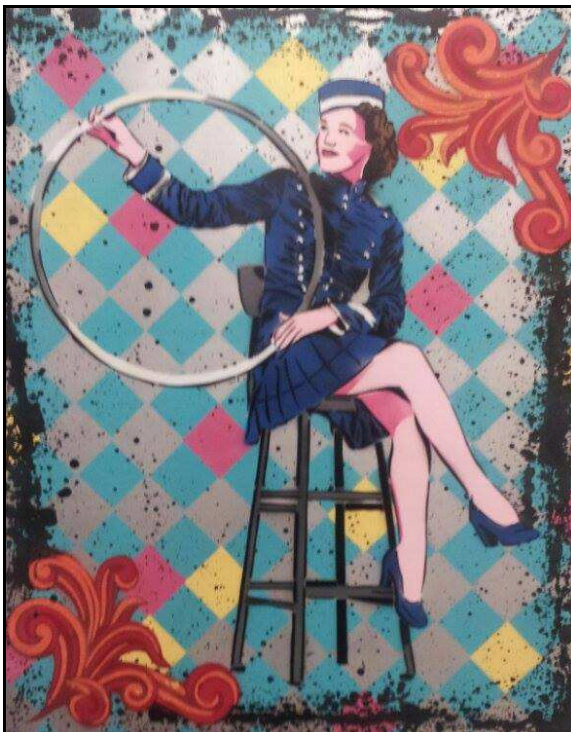
In the fall of 2014, Stone Village Church (SVC) will launch a satellite worship

Blessing of the Animals

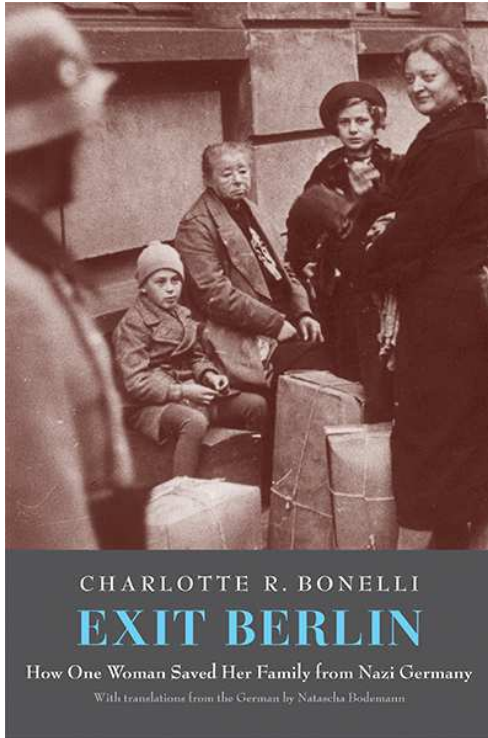
