Year-End Contributions



- Donors may sponsor one or more children. They will receive each child's wish list as a tag on the Christmas Tree in the Children's Hallway on the lower level of the church beginning Sunday, November 23, shop for the toys, wrap each gift separately, and deliver them to Holiday Wish.
- Individuals and groups may also contribute new, unwrapped toys and gifts of their choice and drop them off at King Avenue.


