Please bring these items on the first day of school, they will go back and forth daily.

Please label these items with your child's name.

- 1 backpack (must be large enough to easily fit folder) preferably with a side pouch for water bottle
- 1 lunchbox
- 1 leak-proof water bottle (with a built-in straw or pull up sports cap)
- 1 gallon-size zip lock bag with a complete change of seasonal clothing for your child (stays in backpack)
- 1 PLASTIC folder with bottom pockets (not side pockets) Paper folders do not last.

FOR NAP TIME: An all-in-one fabric nap roll (check Amazon) Due to limited space, please do not send mats, pillow pets, sleeping bags or large blankets. One small stuffed animal is ok. (nap rolls will go home on Fridays)

Please bring these supplies the evening of Orientation.

- 1 10x7 ½ metal-zippered pencil pouch with clear window and 3 grommets (3-ring binder holes)- label with child's name
- 2 boxes of 24 Crayola crayons
- 2 LARGE washable glue sticks (place one in pencil pouch)
- 12 pack of regular-size yellow #2 pencils (Ticonderoga are the best)
- 2 pink rectangle erasers (place one in pencil pouch)
- 1 package of Crayola Washable markers (primary colors) 8 or 10 pack
- 4 count EXPO dry erase markers (not Crayola brand) in any color for student use
- 1 pair of child size scissors- (please remove any packaging, label with child's name and place in pencil pouch)
- 3 packages of baby wipe REFILLS
- 4 boxes of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 box of Band-Aids
- 1 4-pack of Play-Doh (4 oz size)



Please LABEL (with your child's name) ONLY the following items:

backpack, lunchbox, water bottle, clothing bag, folder, nap items, pencil pouch, scissors

Please assist us by placing ONLY the specific items listed below in your child's pencil pouch:

scissors, 1 glue stick and 1 pink rectangle eraser (nothing else should be in it for the first day of school)
