

Calvary Christian School Kindergarten Supply List 2026-2027

Please bring these items on the first day of school, they will go back and forth daily.

Please label these items with your child's name.

1 backpack (must be large enough to easily fit folder) preferably with a side pouch for water bottle

1 lunchbox

1 leak-proof water bottle (with a built-in straw or pull up sports cap)

1 gallon-size zip lock bag with a complete change of clothing for your child (stays in backpack)

FOR NAP TIME: An all-in-one fabric nap roll (check Amazon). Due to limited space, please do not send pillow pets, sleeping bags, blankets, or pillows. One small stuffed animal is okay. Nap rolls will go home on Fridays.

Please bring supplies by the evening of Orientation.

1 PLASTIC RED folder & 1 PLASTIC ORANGE folder with bottom pockets (not side pockets) Paper folders do not last.

1 pencil box - please without pop-its or fidgets

4 boxes of 8 pack Crayola crayons

2 LARGE washable glue sticks

24 pack of regular-size yellow #2 pencils (Ticonderoga are the best)

4 pink rectangle erasers

1 package of Crayola Washable markers (primary colors) 8 or 10 pack

4 count EXPO brand dry erase markers (not Crayola brand) in any color for student use

1 pair of child size scissors ***check for left/right handed scissors as needed

3 packages of baby wipe REFILLS

4 boxes of tissues

3 containers of Clorox disinfecting wipes

3 rolls of paper towels

1 box of quart size ziplock bags, 1 box of snack size ziplock bags

1 4-pack of regular size Play-Doh

one pair of earbuds or headphones for tech class/map testing (please place these in a zip-lock bag with your child's first and last names on it)

Please put your child's name on the following items ONLY: backpack, lunch box, clothing bag, water bottle, folders, pencil box, scissors, nap items.

Please assist us by placing ONLY the specific items listed below in your child's pencil box: scissors, 1 glue stick and one pink rectangle eraser (nothing else should be in it for the first day of school)
