Health

Erlene completed 20 weeks of chemotherapy on February 19 and 6 weeks of daily radiation on April 20. It has been a extremely long and arduous road, but the active treatment is now complete. Risk of recurrence is high, so she will remain on medication to prevent the cancer from returning.
