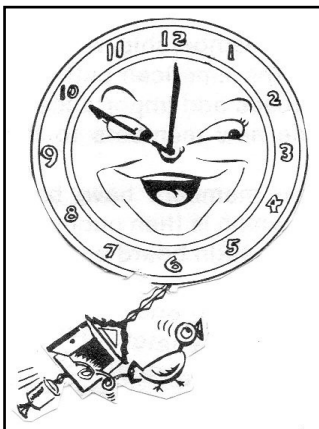
When Time Talks

PLEASE READ**

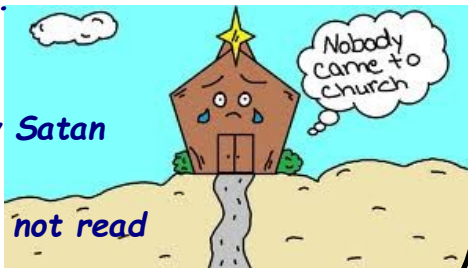


Dear Church Members,
