

The text is a direct response from God to Solomon's request at the dedication of the Temple in Chapter 6. This message was relevant for Israel then. It is relevant today for the church and our nation as a whole 2 Chron. 7: 14 is a formula/key for revival!


He is? A Monument of man or a Movement of God's Spirit where most likely you will get persecuted and God alone gets all the glory and worship for what He has done.
