Position Summary:

Camp Counselor will be responsible for providing supervision and direction for the Summer Day Camp program and participants. Staff responsibilities include activity planning, leading daily field trips, leading interest clubs with campers, and overall camp assistance. Applicants **MUST BE AVAILABLE** Monday through Friday from 7:00am – 6:00pm.

Responsibilities:

- Assist in programming and daily planning to promote social, physical, and intellectual growth of children ages 5-12 under supervision of Director of Programs
- Maintain a healthy and safe learning environment which meets each child's social, emotional, cognitive, and physical health needs
- Communicate with parents daily
- Liaise with the Director of Programs and attend all staff trainings and meetings

Qualifications:

- 1. Must be available Monday through Friday 7:00am 6:00pm
- 2. At least **18 years** of age
- 3. Have a high-school diploma
- 4. Have a Driver's License with a clean driving record
- 5. Must have **1-year** of experience in a relevant camp or classroom setting with children ages 5-12
- 6. Obtain CPR/First Aid and AED certification within one week of hire
- 7. Must submit a negative TB test within one week of hire
- 8. Must submit proof of Bloodborne pathogens training with one week of hire
- 9. Must submit proof of Food Handlers Card within one week of hire
- 10. Must submit and be cleared by Washington State Department of Early Learning portable background check

Hours:

Full-Time 35 hours+ per week, Monday – Friday. Occasional weekend trainings and weekly evening staff meetings.
