





#### **Brief Beliefs:**

We believe the Bible is God's Word given by divine inspiration, the record of God's revelation of Himself to humanity (Second Timothy 3:16). It is trustworthy, sufficient, without error, the supreme authority and guide for all doctrine and conduct (First Peter 1:23-25; John 17:17; Second Timothy 3:16-17). It is the truth by which God brings people into a saving relationship with Himself and leads them to Christian maturity (John 20:31; First John 5:9-12; Matthew 4:4; First Peter 2:2). \*Taken from our *North American Baptist Statement of Faith* 

#### **To Illustrate:**

Second Timothy 3:16 describes the Bible as a spiritual navigation system (similar to a GPS or phone maps when driving) for our journey through life. "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness." *Doctrine* tells us which road to travel; *reproof* tells us when we are off the road; *correction* tells us how to get back on; instruction in righteousness tells us how to stay on God's road. So – to stay on course, trust the compass of God's Word.


