Brief Beliefs:

We believe the Bible is God's Word given by divine inspiration, the record of God's revelation of Himself to humanity (Second Timothy 3:16). It is trustworthy, sufficient, without error, the supreme authority and guide for all doctrine and conduct (First Peter 1:23-25; John 17:17; Second Timothy 3:16-17). It is the truth by which God brings people into a saving relationship with Himself and leads them to Christian maturity (John 20:31; First John 5:9-12; Matthew 4:4; First Peter 2:2).

To Illustrate:

Second Timothy 3:16 describes the Bible as a spiritual navigation system (similar to a GPS or phone maps when driving) for our journey through life. "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness." *Doctrine* tells us which road to travel; *reproof* tells us when we are off the road; *correction* tells us how to get back on; *instruction in righteousness* tells us how to stay on God's road. So – to stay on course, trust the compass of God's Word.

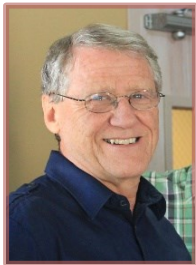

Q – Who were the “sons of God”?

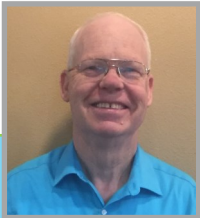
A – Some say they were godly men descended from Seth who married sinful women descended from Cain. Others say they were human rulers who emerged as heads of city-states in the ancient Middle East and flaunted their power by having large harems as rulers and judges are sometimes called gods or God in the Hebrew text. Others suggest they were supernatural beings such as angels/demons. Bottom line: We are not told specifically.
