

Dan Mulkey, Building Committee Chairman

We continue to work with the county to gain approval to begin building. Dan Mulkey, DuWayne Weber and Lorn Larson have been meeting with the architect, Pierce County and Rainier View Water. Listed below are the items that need to be addressed:

- 1) Sewer line sizes and drains in the kitchen
- Staging around the kitchen exhaust fan on the roof for maintenance.
- 3) Mezzanine floor support from 60 lbs. per square foot to 100 lbs. per square foot.
- 4) Fire alarm electrical drawings.
- 5) Door hardware schedule to meet egress safety standards.
- Additional fire hydrant, which will require additional cost depending on location and pipe size.
- 7) Fire marshal requires additional egress emergency lighting.

Please continue to pray with us as we move forward in this process.


