Our annual community block party looks like it will be held in August at a date and time yet to be determined. I plan to run a four week summer series on the life of King David in July. This series will be held on Wednesdays at 12noon in the Fireside Room from July 8-29. Lunch will be provided for those who would like to join us in person, or you can watch on our church's Facebook page from the comforts of your own home.
