"Come to Bethlehem and See"

The season of Advent, the four weeks leading up to Christmas, is upon us. Advent is a time of preparing, waiting, and expecting our Savior to come into our world. Waiting is often very difficult as we want things instantaneously. We have become accustomed to fast food restaurants, microwaveable meals, and high speed internet. When we have to wait, whether at the doctor's office, in line at the grocery store, or for the light to turn green, we can grow impatient.

As we await Christmas there are several things are church is offering to help us draw closer to God during this special season:

Advent devotionals are available for free in the gallery. These daily devotionals, titled *Prepare Ye*, include a short devotional reading, scripture verse, and prayer. I would invite you to pick up one of these devotionals to use during the season of Advent to prepare our hearts and minds in Christ.

I will be leading an Advent series class titled, *A Turning Point* beginning this Sunday, December 6 at 9:15 AM in the Fireside Room. This three week class will be looking at the Old Testament book of Isaiah and discover why it provides a turning point in our faith. Although written 700 years before the birth of Jesus, the prophet Isaiah had the wonderful gift of being able to look ahead to discover what awaits us. Our Angel Tree is in the gallery with various tags to help people during this Christmas season. We will be helping three groups this Christmas: low income kids in our community, those served through the Presbyterian Mission Agency, and some of our shut-ins who have been isolated during this pandemic. I am preaching an Advent sermon series titled, *Come to Bethlehem and See* based on the birth stories of Jesus as told in Matthew and Luke. This series is centered around the aspects of recognizing, responding, receiving, and returning...all intending to draw us into a deeper relationship with Christ.

Zoom, Zoom, a Caroling will be held on Sunday, December 20 at 2 PM. Join Sandi Rabas and I for 45 minutes as we sing and share some of our favorite Christmas carols via Zoom. Watch for the Zoom link that will be published in the e-news and bulletin as the date gets closer.

Christmas Eve services will be offered on Thursday, December 24 at 5 PM and 10 PM. Due to social distancing protocol, we are asking you to choose to attend just one service this year.
